## The next phase of the visitation is as follows:

- Visitation will be conducted in our outside visitation stations and inside stations.
- Visitation will be conducted within the Activities Room/Patio/MSU Patio
- · All visitors will enter through the Activities Room entrance doors
- Upon arrival all visitors will be screened, with temperatures, hand hygiene and questionnaire
- During visitation we require all guests to adhere to the 6-foot social distance and instructions from the CTKM team
- Visitors must wear masks during the entire visits
- Limited to 2 individuals during the inside visits, outside visits the number of visitor can be greater

## **HOURS OF VISITATION:**

- Monday through Friday 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.
- Tuesday and Wednesday extended hours from 6:30p.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- Saturday and Sunday 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.

## **Scheduling Instructions:**

- All visitors will call the receptionist to schedule an inside/outside visits.
- All visitation will be conducted in the Activities Room/Patio/MSU Patio
- Visitors will enter through the Activities room doorway, be screened with temperature check, asked questionnaire, complete hand hygiene and required to wear appropriate face mask.
- Visitors will be escorted to the designated area with a team member of CTKM, reminded of all protocols and safety measures required. Visits are limited to 30 minutes.
- During these visits, we will still be encouraging 6-foot social distancing, face coverings, and cleaning of hands.
